



Campbell County Democratic Party Meeting Minutes

The January Meeting of the Campbell County Democratic Party was called to order by Chairwoman Heidi Kennedy at 6:05 pm. We observed a moment of silence for Renee Good, a peaceful observer slain by an ICE officer in Minneapolis, and for the state of our nation and the current political environment. Eleven people were present including Heidi. Attendees introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes from last meeting:

- Minutes of the November 2025 meeting were approved by consensus.

Approval of Agenda:

- By consensus, the agenda was approved.

Treasurer's Report:

- Heidi is the acting treasurer; however, she would welcome anyone to take this position.
- Withdrawals/debits: \$54.00 for post office box rental

Announcements from the Chair:

- Community Outreach - We have 265 email and 204 text message subscribers.
- Followers include 341 on Facebook, 2192 on BlueSky, and 84 on Instagram.
- In 2025, Heidi sent 10,179 emails.
- January marks a full year since Heidi has been our local party chair.
- Texting Platform – Let Heidi know if you would like to receive text messages.

Old Business:

- Adopt-a-Highway sign – Heidi has not seen it on the stretch of south Hwy. 59 we adopted. It may not be installed until spring.
- 2026 Midterm Elections discussion – We looked at the spreadsheet in our packets that included every race up for election this year. The Dems would like to “Contest Every Race”, and it was emphasized that we would be doing the state a favor if we contest legislative races too.
- Advertising – We will wait until after the May filing period to determine what advertising to pay for.
- Free Little Library – Heidi added Kamala Harris’ memoir, 107 Days. She’s ordered Forgotten Americans, a recommendation by Elaine R. Anyone can borrow a book from this portable library or bring one that they think people would like.
- T-shirt sales: See Heidi if you would like to order a sky-blue CC Democratic Party t-shirt.

New Business:

- March Central Committee Meeting – Open to all registered Democrats in Campbell County, people have a say in the party platform and can elect delegates to the state convention on June 6-7. We may have up to 20 delegates. We must advertise the meeting in the paper. Heidi would like to send postcards to every registered Dem regarding the meeting. We will need to elect a convention chair to run the meeting. Heidi will have more information about the process later. It can be done during the regular monthly meeting, especially if we have looked over the current platform ahead of time.
- Events – Heidi included Local governmental meetings and party events up through June in our packet. We have an Event committee, and people are encouraged to volunteer for this. Be thinking about helping with our Spring highway cleanup, our summer picnic

before the primary so candidates can attend, a possible holiday party, a float or walking in the 4th of July parade.

- Precinct Committee People – If you are a regular who attends monthly meetings, consider becoming a precinct committee man or woman. It would be great to have every precinct position in Campbell County covered. This is the way you can vote on matters important to the party.

State Party Announcements:

- Caucuses – People interested in serving on the following caucuses are invited to apply for them: Women; Minorities; and Labor. When they're organized, they will meet monthly on Zoom. Lindee S., volunteered for the Women's Caucus.
- Young Democrats – This is for people ages approximately 18 – 30 or 35, and is a statewide group that will meet on Zoom for now.
