



Campbell County Democratic Party Meeting Minutes

The March Meeting of the Campbell County Democratic Party was called to order by Chairwoman Heidi Kennedy at 6:30 pm. Twelve people were present including Heidi. Attendees introduced themselves.

Jim Byrd, Democratic candidate for the Wyoming U.S. Senate addressed everyone about the importance of being a Democrat, and the importance of his race. He asked everyone to help him out either financially, or by finding other Democrats and making sure they're registered and getting them out to vote.

Approval of Minutes from last meeting:

- Billy M. moved that the minutes of the February 2026 meeting be accepted. The minutes were approved by consensus.

Approval of Agenda:

- Karin E. moved and Billy M. seconded approval of the agenda. By consensus, the agenda was approved.

Treasurer's Report:

- Heidi is the acting treasurer; however, she would welcome anyone to take this position.
- Credits/deposits: Heidi reported that since our last meeting we have received \$615.00 in donations. With this money, we will advertise for our county convention.
- Debits/withdrawals: There were no expenses this month.

Announcements from the Chair:

- No Kings Protest: An organizing meeting hosted by Campbell County ACTION directly was held following our monthly meeting. People were invited to stay to see what the plan was.
- Community Outreach
 - Facebook: 505 followers, 64 new since last month
 - BlueSky: 379 followers, 16 new since last month
 - Instagram: 103 followers, 11 new since last month
 - TikTok: 13 followers, 5 new since last month
 - Texting platform: 277 subscribers, -1 since last month
 - Email platform: 284 subscribers, 11 new since last month
- Free Little Library: Heidi has a bookshelf and added *Jesus and John Wayne* to the free library.
- T-Shirt sales: Order forms available
- Precinct Committee People: One of Heidi's goals is to have a precinct person in every precinct.

Old Business:

- Adopt-a-Highway sign – One has not been seen yet, but Heidi left a message at WYDOT.
- 2026 Midterm Elections discussion: A link to the spreadsheet with who is running for office this year was shared at the meeting and there was discussion around candidates who have declared their campaigns.

New Business:

- County Central Committee Meeting
 - Date: Saturday, April 18th at 9:00 AM
 - Venue: Campbell County Public Library (Pioneer Rooms 1 & 2)
 - Advertising: Brenda K. recommended that we ask for the “Public Notice Rate” from the News-Record. Otherwise, a small ad costs \$257. A postcard will be mailed to every single registered Democrat in Wyoming.
 - Committees:
 - Credentials Committee: Karin Ebertz & Linda Stewart
 - Platform & Resolutions Committee: Brenda Kirk, Bob O’Neil and Heidi Kennedy (Heidi stated that the platform should be as short as possible and a document that candidates can run on)
 - Rules or parliamentarian support: Bob O’Neil will help Heidi if there are any questions. (Brenda K. stated that we should use Scribner’s Law and agree that the wording doesn’t have to be perfected if we all understand the meaning of the plank)
- Advertising for building up the party
 - Several ideas were tossed around and we will decide on some advertising in the coming months.
 - If we have some catchy ideas, we might want to put it up on electronic billboards.
 - Letters to the editor: Pick a few ideas and have different people write them up.
- Events: Heidi prepared a list of events we might be interested in.

State Party Announcements:

- The WYO Dem State Central Committee Meeting
 - The March 14 th meeting was mainly to vote on allowing Niobrara County to have two delegates to the state convention. Motion passed.
 - State Party Convention: June 6 th in Casper. Be thinking about whether you’d like to serve as a delegate. We will elect 20 delegates at the County meeting.
 - The annual Nellie Tayloe Ross fundraising dinner will also be held during this weekend. This event raises funds for the Wyoming Democratic Party.
