- County Fair (July 24th - August 2nd, 2026) - Several people at our monthly coffee meeting thought that the CCDEMS should have a booth this year at the County Fair. This would be a great opportunity to let people know we exist and are active. If we decide to do that then here are some things to consider:
 - The inside booth costs \$75 for a 10ft x 10ft space that includes 1 8ft table and 2 chairs. Electricity is optional.
 - Our booth has to be set up on July 28th (between 9AM and 9PM)
 - Our booth has to be torn down on August 1st after 7:00PM)
 - Our booth needs to be manned from July 29th through August 1st (4 days) between 10AM and 7PM.
 - We will need volunteers to help, set up, tear down and man the booth in shifts.
- Call For Precinct Committee People
 - The main role of a precinct committee person is to be a voting member of the executive committee of the Campbell County Democratic Party. They get to vote on the important direction of our party.
 - We can have 2 precinct committee people, one woman and one man, per precinct of which we have 37 precincts. That means our executive committee could be 80 people (74 precinct people plus Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, State Committee Woman & State Committee Man).
